During the summer term in Nursery we would be moving on from learning about nocturnal animals to exploring different sea creatures and minibeasts. Watch the story or if you have a copy of the book a home you may choose to read it. When listening to the story ask your child questions such as:

What do you think will happen next? How did the whale feel? Where was the whale? How do you think the story will end? What word rhymes with snail?

Activity Ideas:

- I. Retell the story verbally, talking about your favourite parts.
- 2. Identify rhyming words in the story.
- 3. Draw a story map that sequences events as they happen in the story.
- 4. Draw a picture of your favourite character and label.
- 5. Create a scene from the story using materials of your choice.
- 6. Go on a mini beast hunt in the garden.
