
Home Learning - What the Ladybird Heard 29.06.2020

- 2. Draw a story map that sequences events as they happen in the story.
- 3. Draw a picture of your favourite character and label.
- 4. Create a scene from the story using materials of your choice.
- 5. Create a ladybird and make movable spots that can be counted match to numeral

For the children who are attending Nursery they are listening to this story as well as practising their names and learning letter sounds: m, a, s, d, t and i. t
